LEARNING FROM ACCIDENTS NO. 30/2023 POTENTIAL HAZARDOUS INCIDENT FROM 019/2023 FROM 07.11.2023 r.

ACCIDENT DESCRIPTION: while trying to pass through the door to the corridor, there was a blow to the hand with the handle due to its simultaneous opening from two sides



INJURIES: injury to the second finger of the right hand

PLACE OF THE ACCIDENT: building of the Main Library

DIRECT CAUSES OF THE ACCIDENT: being hit by a door handle in the hand while opening it simultaneously from two sides: by the injured person and another worker

INDIRECT CAUSES OF THE ACCIDENT: Inability to check if someone else is opening the door, insufficient concentration on the activity being performed

CORRECTIVE AND PREVENTIVE ACTIONS:

- Consider the need to install a peephole in the door to allow users to observe each other
- Discuss the causes and circumstances of an accident at work in the Access and Information Branch of the Main Library, with particular attention to the possible dangers of opening doors on the passageways of the BG building
- Initiate a change in the job risk assessment
