
LEARNING FROM ACCIDENTS No. 46/2025 INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENT NO. 017/2025 FROM 15.07.2025, No. 018/2025 FROM 30.07.2025



ACCIDENT DESCRIPTION	while riding his bicycle on an internal road, the victim rode under the barrier and, avoiding its arm, hit the curb and then the pole	at a pedestrian crossing blocked by a car, the victim stopped, got off his bicycle, and while trying to lift it onto a high curb, he caught the wheel, lost his balance, and fell on his left side
INJURY	superficial injury to the wrist and hand	contusion and sprain of the left wrist
PLACE OF ACCIDENT	Oliwa Campus, near entrance gate no. 5	near the Biology Department building
DIRECT CAUSE OF THE ACCIDENT	performing a sudden maneuver while passing under a lowering barrier, which led to a loss of balance and hitting the pole with the right hand	loss of balance and fall onto the left side of the body as a result of the front wheel of the bicycle likely hitting the curb of the sidewalk
INDIRECT CAUSE OF THE ACCIDENT	- failure to comply with traffic signs – riding a bicycle within arm's reach of a barrier, despite the prohibition in force, failure to use an available and designated bicycle path	 attempting to ride over a high curb without properly lifting the front wheel of the bicycle, a parked passenger car on a designated pedestrian crossing
